Lunch

Yachting

Harbor 20 Fleet

The Harbor 20 Fleet, consisting of nine boats, is an extremely active sailing group at SCYC. The Fleet holds races every Wednesday, weather permitting. No experience is necessary and all members are encouraged to participate. Members have the opportunity to rent the three club-owned Harbor 20 sailboats for four-hour outings after demonstrating proper sailing ability.

Cruise Fleet

The Cruise Fleet consists of sailors, powerboaters, and “asphalt cruisers.” The Cruise Fleet schedules four to five annual cruises to areas including Beaufort, Dataw Island, Charleston, Savannah, and other locations. In addition, the group meets monthly to socialize and discuss upcoming cruises and other topics of interest. All members are encouraged to join this very active group.

Racing

The Club hosts several regattas each year. Our Harbor 20 regatta is held in May. SCYC’s Ocean Challenge, held the last weekend in October, is our keelboat regatta. The Ocean Challenge is also the culmination of the year-long Coastal Championship Series raced in Savannah, Beaufort, and Hilton Head. All members are invited to participate in regatta festivities and volunteers are always needed and appreciated!

Lessons

Private and group sailing lessons are offered throughout the year for all ages and experience levels.

Summer Junior Sailing Camp and Junior After School Sailing

SCYC’s Junior Sailing Program is the premier sailing program for Hilton Head Island juniors. Four levels of instruction are offered each summer: Guppy (ages 6 and 7), Learn to Sail, Intermediate, and Racing. Junior After School Sailing is offered each Fall and Spring. The entire SCYC Junior Sailing Staff is U.S. Sailing certified.

Bob Pancoast Sailing Scholarship Fund

The Bob Pancoast Sailing Scholarship Fund, named after the late SCYC member and sailor, enables children to take part in our Junior Sailing program who would not financially be able to do so without this aide. Hundreds of children have learned to sail as a result of this fund and the generosity of members and friends.

Tennis

The Sports Center amenities include 7 beautiful Har-Tru courts, featuring a stadium court, where tennis exhibitions are showcased by the area's top professionals throughout the year.

Mixed Doubles Events

Beach Club


The Beach Club features sunning decks and a kids' pool as well as a convenient bar and grill. Dressing rooms with lockers, showers, and restrooms are nearby. The beaches of Daufuskie Island stretch the length of Haig Point's outer banks where you can enjoy sunbathing, strolling, and shelling.

Bicycling & Kayaking

Enjoy the sea breezes along Beach Road by bicycle or get close to nature in single and double kayaks, available for rent on a daily basis.

Boating

Club members with boats have the opportunity to moor at the Community Dock. Charters are available through the Haig Point Marine Department.



Dining

The 30th Hole Grill Room, located in the Club's antebellum-style clubhouse, serves breakfast, lunch, and winter dinners. The Calibogue Club offers cocktails and dinner, along with breathtaking views of Calibogue Sound and the Intracoastal Waterway.



Equestrian Center

The stables offer a variety of programs for all ages and abilities, including riding lessons, trail and beach rides, and Kids' Camp activities.

Fitness Center

Amenities include state-of-the-art equipment and an adults-only lap pool.

Golf

The Rees Jones Signature Course features 20 holes, including unique par 3s on the 8th and 17th holes. For a more relaxing round, enjoy our 9-hole Osprey course, also designed by Jones.

Tennis

Awarded the 2012 Outstanding Tennis Facility Award from the U.S. Tennis Association, Haig Point's tennis complex features six Har-Tru courts, two of which are lighted for evening play.

Lodging

Overnight accommodations are available in the historic Strachan Mansion or the Haig Point Lighthouse (est.1873).

Getting There

Travel to and from Haig Point is by ferry. The ferry cost is \$25 round trip per person. Complimentary shuttle transportation is available and golf cart rentals are available while visiting Haig Point.



Membership Classification and Fee Schedule

FULL MEMBERSHIP

Full membership to the South Carolina Yacht Club includes access to the clubhouse, dining facilities, social events, tennis and sports center, sailing activities, and over 700 reciprocal clubs including local golf partnerships. The following categories are all considered full members.

Resident

This classification of membership is for those 36 years of age or better whose principal residence or principal place of business is within a 50-mile radius of the Club.

Initiation Fee \$7,500 | Monthly Dues \$330

Non-resident

This classification of membership is for those whose primary residence or place of business is not within a 50-mile radius of the Club.

Initiation Fee \$4,500 | Monthly Dues \$225

Junior

This classification of membership is for those age 35 and under. Upon reaching age 36, Junior Members must convert to Resident status and the applicable dues rate will be effective.

Initiation Fee \$2,500 | Monthly Dues \$210

SPORTS & SAILING

Sports Center

This classification of membership includes use of the **poolside bar & grill, tennis courts, locker rooms, swimming pool, and fitness room**. This classification does not include use of the clubhouse, sailing or reciprocal clubs.

Windmill Harbour Property Owners: Initiation Fee \$1,000 | Monthly Dues \$205
Outside Windmill Harbour: Initiation Fee \$1,500 | Monthly Dues \$225

Junior Sports

This classification of membership is for those 18 and under that are active in the SCYC Tennis or Sailing Program, and whose parents are not members. Access is limited to participation in SCYC regattas, matches, tennis or sailing activities and practices.

Initiation Fee \$500 | Monthly Dues \$60
